Why Asset Management?

- Federal Common Rule
- Counties' ability to track voting systems
- Counties' ability to track voting system accessories
- Counties' ability to report on maintenance issues

- Description of the property
- Serial Number / Identification
 Number
- Source of property
- Who holds the title

- Condition of property
- Ultimate disposition data
- Data of disposal
- Sale price of property

- Acquisition date
- Cost of the property
- Percentage of Federal funds used in the purchase of the property
- Location use of property

- A physical inventory of the property must be taken and the results reconciled once every 2 years
- Random audit once every 2 years

• A control system must be developed to ensure adequate safeguards to prevent loss, damage or theft of the property. Any loss, damage or theft shall be investigated

 Adequate maintenance procedures must be developed to keep the property in good condition

• If the grantee or subgrantee is authorized or required to sell the property, proper sales procedures must be established to ensure the highest possible return
