- Announcing EL §3-412

Each board of elections shall, at least once every year, conduct a mandatory school for the instruction of election inspectors, poll clerks and election coordinators. They shall be given written notice stating the time and place at which such school or schools shall be held.

Enclosed you will find a registration/absentee ballot application. We are requesting your current information to help ensure that the ballots for the upcoming Elections will reach you in a timely manner. This application is good for ballot requests through General Election 2014. If your address changes during this time you will need to inform us of the change. An electronic ballot may be requested at www.overseasvotefoundation.org. In accordance with the MOVE Act we will be mailing your ballot 45 days prior to the elections. Additional information can be found at www.madisoncounty.org/boe.

The 2011 Primaries will be held on September 13 and this year the primaries are in the towns of Brookfield, DeRuyter and Lenox and are for registered Republicans only. The ballots will be sent out by July 29, 2011.

The General Election will be held on November 8th and all registered voters will be eligible to vote for their representatives. Offices to be elected are listed below and ballots will be sent 45 days prior to the election.

The Presidential Primary will be held next year on April 24, 2012. To be eligible for the election you must be registered in the party that is holding the election.
